What is the Liberty Ride™?

Founded in 2020, the Liberty Ride™ is a Nationwide motorcycle relay of replicas of America's sacred founding documents. Liberty Riders Ride for Liberty united on the common ground of the foundation of American principles.

Each leg of The Liberty Ride™ is a Ride for Liberty reclaiming patriotism and the foundation of American principles as nonpartisan American values.

The just cause for declaring independence in 1776, "Self-evident truths" and "inalienable rights" the nonpartisan foundation of American principles is not debatable political ideology to debate.

To pay proper tribute to revered American heroes, it is not enough to remember sacrifices made for freedom, at the very least, we are obliged to endeavor to be worthy of them. As we celebrate 250 years as the United States, we must be united states.

Liberty Riders are daring to challenge anyone willing to accept our invitation to Ride for Liberty with us, replicas of the sacred documents, signifying recognition of the "Self-evident truths and "inalienable rights" as the foundation of American principles, reaffirming dedication to maintain that foundation and recommit to uphold We the People's Constitution, framed not to grant the inheritance but ensure it is never denied anyone within the United States again.

Embracing "E PLURIBUS UNUM" the earliest American patriots call to unity, telling their story in three words. **Serving to memorialize who the earliest American patriots considered themselves to be, how the founding fathers wanted to be remembered and a reminder of their vision for posterity.**

2026 E PLURIBUS UNUM Ride for Liberty Challenge

- **Step 1: Accept the challenge by receiving** the founding documents
 - Anyone can accept the challenge by receiving a document already in motion. Many are choosing to accept the challenge as a Nomad and ordering replicas online. Most but not all documents arrive in tubes perfect for the Relay! If yours didn't come in a tube, purchase one from any office supply retailer or shipping store.
- **Step 2: Print the Ride For Liberty Challenge Adventure LOG** to include with the documents so everyone who accepts the Challenge knows exactly what to do.
 - Using fine tip permanent markers (Sharpies' fine point pens are highly recommended) Write the hashtag **#RideForLibertyChallenge** clearly across the top of the back of each document like a heading and then underneath the hash tag include the email address LadyLibertyRyder@gmail.com
 - **If you wish, include a "Origin" Note:** On the back of the paper, it could be simply where and when the journey started or a **few words** expressing why you accepted the challenge.
 - **Step 3: Sign the documents.** *You may add your signature or just your zip code or area code.* Whichever mark chosen, signifies **recognition** of the "Self-evident Truths" and "Inalienable Rights" as the non-partisan foundation of American principles, **reaffirms** your dedication to maintain that foundation and the **recommittal** to uphold "We the People's" Constitution, **vowing to exercise your right to vote.**
 - **Take photos** of the documents' journey and transfers. **Those who prefer anonymity, photos do not need to reveal your identity,** photos of the docs at cool local landmarks and historical markers are ideal!
 - **Post photos to Instagram, Facebook, or TikTok** Using the Hash Tag: **#RideForLibertyChallenge**
 - **Anyone uncomfortable connecting their social media presence to the challenge can email photos to LadyLibertyRyder@gmail.com with the information they want shared and we will post them on our social media platforms.**
 - **Location Tags are encouraged** we recommend using the "Add Location" feature on platforms like Instagram or Facebook when posting.
 - **Geo-Hashtags: in lieu of Location tags we encourage the use of state-specific hashtags** (e.g., #Texas, #NewYork) alongside **#RideForLibertyChallenge** to make the state-to-state movement easily searchable for tracking purposes.
- **Step 4: Challenge others to do the same and Pass It On!**
 - Pass the honorable burden to others willing to accept the challenge and commit to keep the liberty journey going. Be sure to **include fine tip permanent markers and the Ride For Liberty Challenge Adventure LOG in the tube before passing it on!**
- **Step 5: The Liberty Ride historically ends in Washington D.C during Constitution week September 17-23, 2026** so send the documents in that direction when possible. Do not expect a direct route. The path will back track some, just keep it moving. We can help guide them so and in most parts of the country have riders to help. Don't hesitate to reach out!

When a document is filled contact the Liberty Ride at LadyLibertyRyder@gmail.com to arrange a final handoff to keep it safe until we can join it with the others and send them home to D.C. together.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness. --That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed.



E Pluribus Unum ("Out of many, one") suggested as the U.S. motto in 1776, by a committee of Founding Fathers including Benjamin Franklin, John Adams, and Thomas Jefferson. Chosen for the Great Seal in 1782 it signifies that thirteen distinct colonies united to form one nation, representing a cohesive identity from diversity.

The Constitution of the United States of America, the world's longest surviving written charter of government. Written in 1787 and ratified in 1788, the Law of the Land since 1789. The first three words – “We The People” – affirm that the government of the United States exists to serve its citizens.
